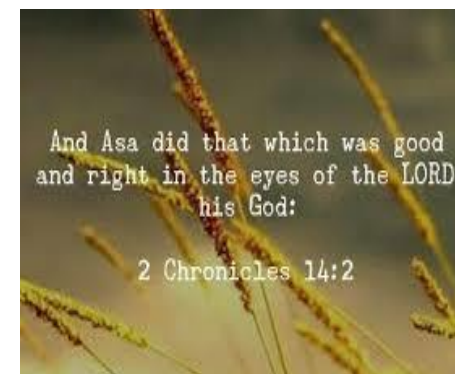

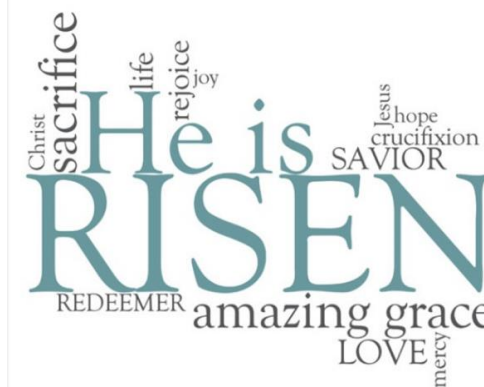

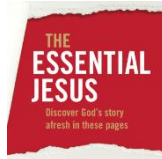

Evangelism



Take a copy of the **Essential Jesus** as you leave church today.

When was the last time you read a whole Gospel and reminded yourself of why Jesus is essential not just for you but for others. Maybe you might know of someone you could give it to. God wants us to be ready to share the good news of Jesus with others.

Today's readings from the Bible

2 Chronicles 14:2-4;15:1-9,11-14

14:2 Asa did what was good and right in the eyes of the LORD his God.³ He removed the foreign altars and the high places, smashed the sacred stones and cut down the Asherah poles.⁴ He commanded Judah to seek the LORD, the God of their fathers, and to obey his laws and commands. 15:1 The Spirit of God came upon Azariah son of Oded.² He went out to meet Asa and said to him, "Listen to me, Asa and all Judah and Benjamin. The LORD is with you when you are with him. If you seek him, he will be found by you, but if you forsake him, he will forsake you.³ For a long time Israel was without the true God, without a priest to teach and without the law.⁴ But in their distress they turned to the LORD, the God of Israel, and sought him, and he was found by them.⁵ In those days it was not safe to travel about, for all the inhabitants of the lands were in great turmoil.⁶ One nation was being crushed by another and one city by another, because God was troubling them with every kind of distress.⁷ But as for you, be strong and do not give up, for your work will be rewarded."⁸ When Asa heard these words and the prophecy of Azariah son of Oded the prophet, he took courage. He removed the detestable idols from the whole land of Judah and Benjamin and from the towns he had captured in the hills of Ephraim. He repaired the altar of the LORD that was in front of the portico of the LORD's temple.⁹ Then he assembled

all Judah and Benjamin and the people from Ephraim, Manasseh and Simeon who had settled among them, for large numbers had come over to him from Israel when they saw that the LORD his God was with him.....¹¹ At that time they sacrificed to the LORD seven hundred head of cattle and seven thousand sheep and goats from the plunder they had brought back.¹² They entered into a covenant to seek the LORD, the God of their fathers, with all their heart and soul.¹³ All who would not seek the LORD, the God of Israel, were to be put to death, whether small or great, man or woman.¹⁴ They took an oath to the LORD with loud acclamation, with shouting and with trumpets and horns.

Matthew 10:32-39 page 688

10:32 "Whoever acknowledges me before men, I will also acknowledge him before my Father in heaven.³³ But whoever disowns me before men, I will disown him before my Father in heaven.³⁴ "Do not suppose that I have come to bring peace to the earth. I did not come to bring peace, but a sword.³⁵ For I have come to turn "a man against his father, a daughter against her mother, a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law--³⁶ a man's enemies will be the members of his own household.'³⁷ "Anyone who loves his father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; anyone who loves his son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me;³⁸ and anyone who does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me.³⁹ Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it.
