



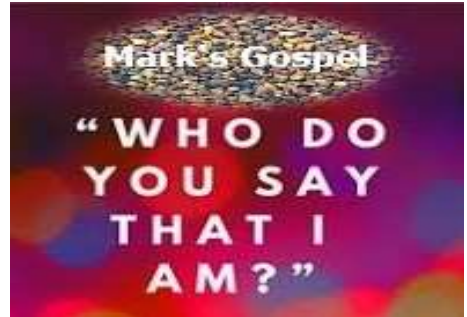
## Welcome to church

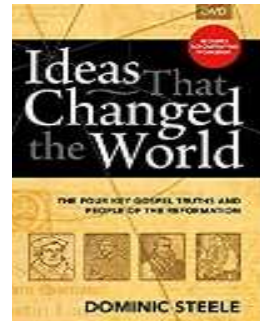

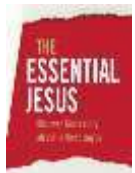
